Effective for new scholarships beginning Fall 2024

Master's Degree Programs¹ in Early Childhood Education

Am I eligible?

- Work as a director, teacher or assistant at least 30 hours/week in a licensed child care center.
- Employed at least 90 days at center.
- Be admitted to an approved graduate school/master's program in early childhood at a participating college or university.
- Obtain agreement from child care center to sponsor scholarship.

What centers can participate?

- Be a licensed child care center in good standing with Arkansas Child Care Licensing.
- Able to financially contribute a percentage of tuition and books.
- Agree to provide scholars with release time (3-6 hours weekly) reimbursed by T.E.A.C.H.
- Pay annual stipend/provide pay increase upon scholar's completion of contract and commitment.
- Better Beginnings accreditation is encouraged.
