Effective for new scholarships beginning Fall 2024

Master's Degree in Early Childhood Education

Am I eligible?1

- Work as a family child care educator at least 30 hours/week in a licensed family child care home.
- Employed in family child care home for least 90 days.
- Be admitted to an approved certificate or degree program in early childhood.
- Able to financially contribute a percentage of tuition and books.

What family child care homes can participate?

- Be a licensed child care home in good standing with Arkansas Child Care Licensing.
- Must demonstrate operation of at least six months in good standing.
- Program may provide FCC educator with release time (3-6 hours weekly reimbursed by T.E.A.C.H.) if qualified substitute staff is available to cover teaching responsibilities.
- Better Beginnings accreditation is encouraged.

Travel Stipend	\$200 per semester	Scholar must complete at least 9 credit hours per year, all with minimum grades required for degree credit.
Release Time	Reimburse FCC program for release time at \$15.00 per hour up to 6 hours per week	
Incentive	Pay scholar \$700 upon completion of contract and commitment	
Technology	Reimburse scholar up to \$500 for purchase of new laptop ²
