Am I eligible?
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Work as director, teacher or assistant at least 30 hours/wk in licensed child care center. Employed at least 90 days. Be admitted to a program in early childhood at a participating college or university.
What centers can participate?
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be a licensed child care center in good standing with Arkansas Child Care Licensing. Able to financially contribute a percentage of tuition, books and annual incentive. Agree to provide scholars with release time (3-6 hours weekly) reimbursed by TEACH. Better Beginnings accreditation at Level 3 or higher is encouraged.
