Am I eligible?

- Work as director, teacher or assistant at least 30 hours/wk in licensed child care center.
- Employed at least 90 days.
- Be admitted to a program in early childhood at a participating college or university.

What centers can participate?

- Be a licensed child care center in good standing with Arkansas Child Care Licensing.
- Able to financially contribute a percentage of tuition, books and annual incentive.
- Agree to provide scholars with release time (3-6 hours weekly) reimbursed by TEACH.
- Better Beginnings accreditation at Level 3 or higher is encouraged.
