



Graduate Program Scholarships ECE Master's Degrees 2026-27 Overview for Arkansas Public Colleges

Earn your advanced degree in early childhood while you work.

Educator Eligibility

- Employed in an eligible position in a licensed child care center for the past 90 days
- Working at least 30 hours per week
- Be admitted to or enrolled in a TEACH-approved certificate, associate or bachelor's degree program in early childhood education
- Position should require or strongly recommend an advanced degree in early childhood education (applicant must justify need for a master's degree)

Employer Eligibility

- Be a licensed child care center in good standing with Arkansas Child Care Licensing
- Contribute a portion of tuition, book and annual incentive
- Provide scholars with release time (up to 96 hours per semester), reimbursed by TEACH
